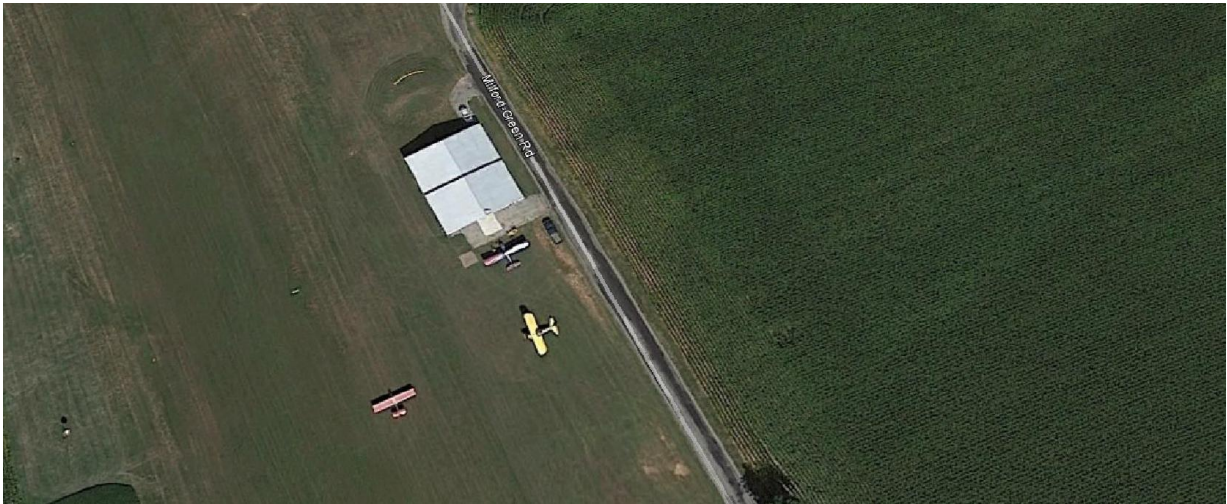


**EAA Chapter 122 Meeting Minutes**

**Make sure you wear identifying apparel** (shirt, hat, and/or nametag) that connects you with the EAA.

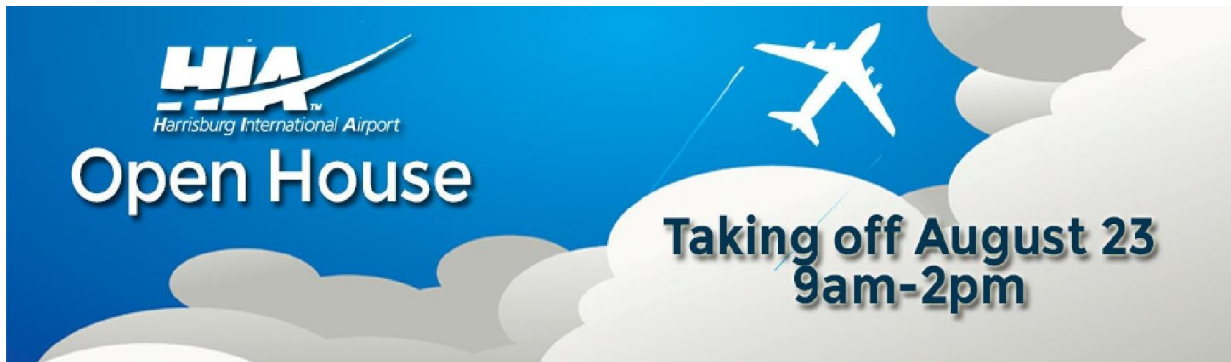
Mike Parks was able to get LB Smith Ford as one of the sponsors with \$1,500. Sponsor's donations go straight to the EAA, not the chapter.
