

# Chapter 122

## Procedures Manual

### Amendment of Chapter 122 bylaws

A member in good standing of EAA Chapter 122 may request an amendment of the Bylaws by introducing the recommended amendment at a regular or special meeting of the organization. This recommendation shall be presented verbally to the members in attendance, and, in writing, to the President. The President shall refer the recommendation to the Board of Directors, who shall review the recommendation for clarity and conformance with existing law, and the requirements of the National Experimental Aircraft Association. During the review process, the Board shall have the authority to modify the proposal for conformance with style and grammar, and to bring it into conformance with existing law and the requirements of the National Experimental Aircraft Association. Reasons for any modification shall be announced to the general membership when the proposal is published for vote. After review, and within 30 days of its introduction, the Board of Directors shall cause the proposal, along with the recommendation of the board as to adoption or rejection, to be published to the entire membership of the chapter. The membership shall have 30 days to consider the recommendation, and its adoption or rejection shall be voted on by all members present at a regular meeting of the chapter not less than 60 days, nor more than 90 days, of its introduction. A two thirds majority of the members voting, a quorum being present, shall be required to adopt an amendment to the chapter bylaws.

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### Applications for membership

Applicants for membership shall complete an approved Membership Application, and submit it to the president of the chapter, who shall present it, along with recommendations, to the Board of Directors. The Board shall vote on acceptance or rejection at the next scheduled meeting of the Board. The applicant shall be permitted all rights and privileges of membership, except voting, pending acceptance by the Board of Directors. Upon acceptance by the Board, the member shall be granted all rights and privileges of membership to include the right to vote on all matters properly brought before the membership. In the event that the application is rejected by the Board, the applicant shall be notified. The Board need not offer reasons for the rejection.
