A Word from the President

WOW- 2007 - What a year for Chapter 122

In May we held our 15th Annual Young Eagles Flight in the past 14 years for the Special Needs Community. Then we hosted the EAA's Ford Tri-Motor in June, then we drove to Oshkosh for AirVenture "07" in late July and then hosted EAA's B-17 Aluminum Overcast in August just a week after getting home from AirVenture "07". The Chapter also sponsored a young man, Brent Shull for the 2006 and 2007 Air Academy.

The week after hosting EAA's B-17 the chapter held it's first Annual Aviation History Weekend at the Carlisle Business Airport. We honored over twenty one WWII Vets on the Saturday of our event and on Saturday night we hosted a Hungar Dance with the Gettysburg Big Band.

On Friday, November 16th, we drove Major Hank Heim, a B-17 & B-29 Pilot who is 86 years young to an elementary school in Sunbury, Pa., about 60 miles from home for Xan Larwrence's Show & Tell in front of over 60 kindergarten children and their teachers.

Major Heim flew 78 missions in the B-17 during WWII and 50 missions in the B-29 during the Korean Conflict. Hank has been interviewed by EAA at Oshkosh.

Xan Larwrence a six year old going on 30 met Major Hank as Hank was sitting in the cockpit of EAA's B-17 explaining his experiences in WWII as a B-17 Pilot during the ground tours of the B-17 at Capital City Airport in New Cumberland, Pa.

On December 18th we will finish the year with our Annual Christmas Party. We plan to honor five WWII Vets at the party, four B-17 WWII crew members and one B-24 crew member all members of our chapter. We will also be presenting EAA Chapter 122's "Keep Em Flyin Award" to two companies who provided funds so that we could bring the EAA's Ford Tri-Motor to the Harrisburg area. We have already presented one of the plaques to LB Smith Ford, Inc.

LB Smith Ford Inc, has provided funds both in 2006 & 2007 for the Tri-Motor and they bought all the seats on the B-17 in 2006 & 2007 for their employees. They are truly a friend of Chapter 122 and the EAA.

The award is a diecast Ford Tri-Motor model attached to a beautiful stand with a brass plaque.
